## Jeppesen Assistance Using VA Benefits

The Jeppesen FAA Dispatcher Certification Course is approved by the Colorado state approving agency for training Veterans and eligible dependents. Individuals who served on active duty may receive funding to cover tuition and possible housing expenses associated with attending the course. Jeppesen adopts policies and terms which are in accordance with Title 38 US Code 3679(e) for any students using U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Post-9/11 G.I. Bill® (Ch. 33) or Vocational Rehabilitation & Employment (Ch. 31) benefits.

## Jeppesen Training Eligible for VA Benefits\*

You may be eligible for tuition assistance through VA benefits including Post-9/11 GI Bill®, Montgomery GI Bill®, and other GI Bill® benefits if you are a: Veteran; Veteran's dependent; a surviving spouse; child or parent of a deceased Veteran; an active duty military service member or a member of the Reserve or National Guard.

The evaluation of previous postsecondary education and training is mandatory and required for VA beneficiaries. For students utilizing Veterans benefits who are approved for transfer credit as a result of this evaluation, the institution will grant appropriate credit, reduce the program length proportionately, notify the student and Veterans Affairs in writing of this decision, and adjust invoicing of the VA accordingly.
