
The *Guided Flight Discovery Instrument/Commercial Syllabus/e-book* is an outline, or framework, for three separate courses of training: the Instrument Rating Course, the Commercial Pilot Certification Course and the Multi-Engine Rating Course. These courses are designed to meet Title 14 CFR Part 141 aeronautical knowledge (ground) training and flight training requirements and can be adapted to meet Title 14 CFR Part 61 requirements. The syllabus provides a basic framework for training in a logical sequence and assigns appropriate study material prior to each lesson.

Updates to the 2021 Guided Flight Discovery Instrument/Commercial Syllabus include:

- Enhanced guidance for implementing concurrent or separate enrollments in the instrument rating course and the commercial pilot certification course.
- Options to use a either a technically advanced airplane (TAA) or a complex airplane for 10 hours of the commercial training.
- A variety of training options for the use of a flight simulator, flight training device (FTD), and/or aviation training device (ATD) in addition to the airplane for instrument training.
- Tables in each ground lesson that contain the lesson objectives and the corresponding Part 141/61 and ACS tasks for each ground lesson.
- Revisions to all task categories and task names that are assigned in each flight lesson to match the exact wording of those tasks in Part 141/61 and the applicable ACS.
- Tables in Appendix B that specify the stages and specific ground and flight lessons in which each ground or flight training task required by Part 141, Part 61, and the applicable FAA Airplane Airman Certification Standards (ACS) is introduced, reviewed and evaluated.










